## Sacramental Program 2026

The Sacramental Program is a set of lessons to support parents in their faith formation of their baptised children.

"To a large extent it is the responsibility of Christian parents to show concern for the initiation of their children to the sacramental life both by forming and gradually increasing a spirit of faith in the children and, sometimes with the help of their instructors who are responsible for catechetical formation, by preparing them for the fruitful reception of the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist."

Introduction to the Order of Confirmation, no. 3.

The purpose of the program is to fulfill the abovementioned call of the Church to complete the Christian initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist. The process includes also preparation and the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance as required in no. 12 of the Introduction of Order of Confirmation, which states that "those faithful possessing the use of reason must be in the state of grace, be properly instructed, and capable of renewing the baptismal promises."

Beginning from 2026 the program will have 3 sets of lessons (Penance in March, Confirmation in June and the Eucharist in November), which if all done in one year will bring too much strain on the children and your family life. For that reason, the program will be divided into two streams.

## Stream 1: Penance and Confirmation

• For children who have been baptised, who are in Year 3 or have turned 8 years of age but have not yet received the Sacrament of Penance and Confirmation – the reception of these two sacraments will conclude the program for these children for 2026. They will be invited to receive First Holy Communion in November 2027.

## Stream 2: The Eucharist

- For children who are in Year 4 or have turned 9 years of age and have already received the sacraments of Penance and Confirmation but have not yet received their First Holy Communion (the Sacrament of the Eucharist).
- For children who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation but have not been prepared for the Sacrament of Penance there is an invitation to participate in the program for Confession and then to wait later in the year for the program for the First Holy Communion

To begin the program parents/guardians are required to attend a preliminary meeting scheduled for Saturday 7th February at 10.30am or after the Sunday Mass on 8th February around 9.45am, both meetings will take place at the Parish Community Centre (the attendance of one will suffice). Unfortunately, if you miss either of these meetings, there will be no catch-up meeting, and you will have to wait to join the new group beginning the Sacramental preparations for 2027.

The Preparation program entails participation in the Sunday Mass as well as preparation classes following the morning Mass on Sundays. Hence, please make sure that your family is ready to join our Parish Community for the Mass at 8.30am. However, the program is designed to empower parents to teach their children the beauty of our faith at home by going through the lessons in the workbook.

These are the next year's dates of the preparation classes:

- ➤ for Reconciliation and Penance (Confession) 22<sup>nd</sup> February; 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> March with the celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation and Penance on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026 at 6.00pm;
- ➤ for Confirmation 24<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> May; 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> June with the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2026 at 6.00pm;
- ▶ for the Eucharist (First Holy Communion) 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> October; 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> November with the celebration of the sacrament of the Eucharist (First Holy Communion) with three options: during Saturday Vigil Mass on 14<sup>th</sup> November at 6pm or Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> November at 8.30am or additional Mass 15<sup>th</sup> November at 12.30pm (the dates of the ceremonies will be decided together with the parents).

In order to accurately document the reception of the sacrament we will need a copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate.

To cover the cost of all materials and office work the fee is \$70 for one child, \$120 for two children and \$180 for three.
